

The Global Industry Practices Committee is continuing to work on initiatives for the first half of 2020, but also focused on assisting with the COVID-19 pandemic wherever possible. Some recent news from NAM (National Association of Manufacturers) regarding the payment of tariffs during the current pandemic is a Customs case-by-case duty deferral. CBP (Customs Border Patrol) is approving, on a case-by-case basis, requests for extended deadlines to pay duties, taxes and fees due to COVID-19. To request a duty deferral, we encourage you to contact Randy Mitchell, Director, Commercial Operations Revenue and Entry (CORE) Division. CBP is also deliberating a more formal duty deferral policy in response to COVID-19, moving away from a case-by-case considerations and establishing a more concrete timeline. A few of our current initiatives are (1) Developing a paperless process for handling of manufacturers COC (Certificate of Compliance) documents. We have ADI and Mouser Electronics leading phase 1 of the project and they have just entered testing in March. (2) The manufacturers council has requested a review of the design registration process to include current, desired and future state across technologies to include active/semiconductor, electromechanical and passive. While working on a scoping document, we are also holding stakeholder meetings with industry leaders to form a collaborative effort. (3) Lastly, we are continuing to work on implementing our 2020 GIPC organizational plan which was announced in December 2019.
