A distributor part number is a unique identification number given by a distributor to a product that already has a manufacturer part number. Such numbers are used internally by the distributor and may also be referred to as a Stock Keeping Unit (SKU).

TPC on Coronavirus - Updated Survey Report



Following their ongoing research on the impact to the electronics supply chain in China from COVID-19; TPC ran a 2nd special survey in early March. The survey had roughly 4,000 respondents with approximately 85% located in China.

Some key results include:

- 57% of the respondents are seeing an incremental negative impact over the past 2 weeks to demand and/or production from the virus vs. 83% previously.
- Roughly one-third of the respondents see production down more than 10% for C1Q due to the virus' impact which is down vs. 48% from our <u>February survey</u>. Another 47% see it down 6-10% vs. previous production plans.
