Due to the ongoing COVID pandemic, the CE-2 Connector and Socket Standards Committee and the Fall 2020 Engineering Summit recently took place via web conferences.

A number of new projects were opened:

- **5470** Review of EIA-958 Surface Mount Common Mode Choke Qualification Specification
- **5471** Review of EIA-198-3 Ceramic Dielectric Capacitors Classes I, II, III and IV Part III: Individual Specifications
- **5472** Reaffirmation of 13 nationally adopted IEC standards
- **5473** National adoption of IEC 60384-13-2020 Fixed capacitors for use in electronic equipment Part 13: Sectional specification Fixed polypropylene film dielectric metal foil d.c. capacitors
