Global Compliance: What Manufacturers Need to Know about New Chemical Reporting Obligations under the EU's SCIP Database

New European Union requirements poised to go into effect in January 2021 could require manufacturers across supply chains to publicly disclose significant new information about chemicals used in their products in a matter of weeks, with a potentially sizable impact for manufacturers in the United States and around the world. These obligations result from the European Chemical Agency's <u>October 2020 rollout of a new public database designed to support the circular economy</u> (known as the "SCIP database").

Weekly Economic Trends National Association of Manufacturers

By special agreement ECIA is pleased to present NAM Chief Economist Chad Moutray's weekly analysis of key U.S. government economic data and manufacturing industry trends in the <u>NAM Economic</u> <u>Report - 12/07</u>. the SCIP database and potential obligations. The webinar will include a detailed presentation on the SCIP database and key implications and considerations facing manufacturers, as well as a moderated Q&A session with the speakers: <u>Dr. Herbert</u> <u>Estreicher</u>, Partner, Keller & Heckman LLP (Washington and Brussels) and <u>Ales Bartl</u>, Associate, Keller & Heckman LLP (Brussels).

As of January 5, ECHA will require companies producing, importing or selling in Europe to notify into the database any use of <u>chemicals of concern</u> in their products and components in ways that go beyond existing requirements. These new requirements will impact a broad range of manufacturers large and small, <u>both those doing business in Europe and those</u> <u>manufacturing components and subcomponents that are</u> <u>incorporated into products sold in Europe.</u> Yet many manufacturers in the United States still have fundamental compliance questions about the SCIP database, including whether it applies to them, how the notification process works, how to address technical issues related to notifications and how the database obligations will be enforced at the national level.
