ECIA Elects Board Members at Semi-Annual Joint Council Meeting

Atlanta--The three ECIA councils (Distributor, Manufacturer and Independent Manufacturer Representative) met in Savannah for the organization's semi-annual Joint Council Session. New council positions were filled and the ECIA Board of Directors elected three new members:
